

## DJ USDA Report: Recap For May Production, Supply And Demand

CHICAGO (Dow Jones)--The following table is provided as a service to Dow Jones Newswires subscribers in conjunction with the U.S. Department of Agriculture's May supply and demand report.

The report is scheduled for release at 8:30 a.m. EDT (1230 GMT) Thursday. U.S. estimates are in billions of bushels except soyoil, which is in billions of pounds. Soymeal is in short tons. Cotton is in millions of 480-pound bales. Rice is in million hundredweight. World crop forecasts are in millions of metric tons.
